

Instructions for question paper setting (C-Scheme)

B.Tech/M.Tech-1st Semester Only (2019-20).

1. Each question paper shall have 9 questions in all. First 8 questions should be from 4 units of the syllabus with the condition that there should be 2 questions from each unit (every question should be set from entire syllabus of the particular unit with same weightage of marks and BL). Question No. 9 shall be compulsory.
2. Each question except the compulsory question shall have minimum 2 and maximum 4 parts. The compulsory question i.e. Q.No.9 shall have minimum 5 and maximum 8 parts with the conditions that there should be atleast 1 part in compulsory question from each unit of the syllabus.
3. Paper setter shall mention the marks, Bloom's Level (BL) of each part of the question. The Bloom's Level shall be like BL1, BL2 etc. Multiple Blooms Level should be avoided.

Following are Bloom's Level:-

Bloom's Taxonomy Levels (1-Remembering, 2-Understanding, 3-Applying, 4-Analysing, 5-Evaluating, 6-Creating).
